Message from our Principal

Kia ora tatou,

What an amazing start we have had to the school year. I would like to acknowledge the support from all our families for ensuring the children are set up for a successful school year. We are very mindful that the start of the school year can be very expensive, so thank you. Please keep in mind we welcome expenses to be paid over time throughout the year if this is an option you would prefer.

Our whole school assemblies will continue to be held every Tuesday afternoon in the hall at 2:15pm. Each week one of our classes has the opportunity to host the assembly and to be up on stage, sharing their learning with the rest of the school. It is an afternoon full of learning celebrations and awards, as shields for each class are also awarded. Parents, whanau, family members are always welcome to attend. Our first assembly for the 2021 year was a singing assembly in the hall yesterday. Next week Room 5 will host the first classroom assembly for the year. We will continue in numerical order for class hosting and learning sharing (the following week Room 6, week after Room 7 and so on).


